Walking along side our clients – Child, Youth, Family, this role offers professional and holistic case management services to youth, their families and children within Pregnant Girls Services.

Key Responsibilities

- Provide crisis intervention and counselling to the pregnant girls, their partners and their families
- Continual assessment to secure safety of client according to child protection principles
- Facilitate the process of well-informed decision-makings during the crisis pregnancy, and the follow-up process of the baby plan implementation, including adoption, parenting and abortion.
- Counselling to provide emotional support, enhance relational system and other protective factors
- Connect and work with other resources, including internal program offered in Mother's Choice, and other external program available in NGOs, SWD, hospitals, etc. for the client and baby's welfare
- Plan, lead and run preventive programs and therapeutic groups
- Consultation to hotline callers (including suspected or confirmed pregnant girls, partners, parents, relatives, friends, other professionals, etc.), and engage for further service
- Maintain case history records and prepare reports accurately and timely

Requirements

- Registered Social Worker or experienced caseworker/counsellor in youth or family casework discipline, for at least 5 years. Candidates with less experience will be considered caseworker.
- Holding a Bachelor degree or above in social work, counselling, or related professional practice discipline
- Preferably with some knowledge and experience in the areas of crisis management, trauma-informed care, decision-making counselling, family therapy, grief and loss counselling, child-care/parenting, etc. Willing to learn and develop new knowledge and skills.
- Able and willing to put client as the center of consideration, respect and support their choices, upon well-informed decisions are made.
- Flexible and balance in counselling, assessment and problem solving
- Excellent spoken and written communication and interpersonal skills
- Must share the commitment of Mother's Choice in upholding the safety and protection of children as paramount
