The **MC Craft Makers Club** is a fun yet rewarding way for students to spend time building, exploring and creating together while also having a positive impact in our community. The **MC Craft Makers Club** provides support to Mother's Choice through creative, hands-on projects that celebrate kids' natural creativity and curiosity, while also be able to learn about the issues that vulnerable children, young girls and their families in our community face.

At Mother's Choice, we believe that everyone has a role to play and that everyone can make a difference, including the youngest in our community!

### How the MC Craft Makers Club Works

Crafting encourages us to think, learn and create in new and innovative ways. Working under the supervision of an experienced (volunteer) Project Manager, students will work on different craft projects, on a 2-week project-basis, that supports different departments at Mother's Choice.

1. **July 6-17** – A project to support Foster Care
2. **July 20-31** – A project to support Fundraising.
3. **Aug 3-14** – A project to support Children Services
4. **Aug 17-28** – A project to support Volunteer Engagement.

Here are the steps for each Project:

- Each project kickstarts with a briefing session (Zoom) on the Monday that all students must join.
- On the Zoom call, the Project Manager will provide clear instructions for the new project as well as interview a member of the Mother's Choice team to explain the need for this project.
- Students will have two weeks to work on the craft project from home.
- At the end of two weeks, all craft handiworks are mailed to Mother's Choice.



### The Benefits to Students

- Learn new skills and ways of expressing themselves.
- Develop a sense of purpose and fulfilment by making a positive impact in our city.
- Gain work experience in a non-profit.
- Become acquainted with other “like-minded” volunteers.

### Requirements of Students

We are looking for enthusiastic students who are:

- Passionate about the art of “creating”
- Curious and self-motivated
- Enthusiastic and organised and know how to receive direction
- Socially minded & genuinely care about the work of Mother's Choice

### Commitment of Students

- Due to COVID-19, the **MC Craft Makers Club** is a remote position.
- Minimum hours per week is determined by each student and the amount of time that he/she would like to devote to a project.
- Minimum 2-week commitment, by project.
- Shares Mother's Choice commitment in upholding the safety and protection of children.
