### Position Description

The overall role of the speech therapist is to enhance the communication ability and swallowing ability of children with special needs in Child Care Home, which includes pragmatic skills, speech, language and hearing abilities. This position works with other multi-disciplinary team members namely occupational therapist, physiotherapist, child care workers, nurses, social worker and others whenever is necessary.

### Key Responsibilities

- Casework
  - Give assessment, treatment and evaluation of treatment to children with language delay, communication disorder or hearing problem, swallowing problem.
  - Prepare IEP for child care workers to work individually with the children.
  - Evaluate and record progress and update IEP.
  - Suggest children's diet texture and consistency.
- Administration
  - Prepare case notes and update information regularly.
  - Prepare written reports for general recording and for medical appointments and follow up clinics.
  - Provide other written reports as required, e.g. for kindergarten, adoption agency, etc.
  - Procure and maintain equipment as necessary.
  - Conduct training to staff and volunteers.
- Supervision
  - Supervise and train child care workers in delivery of therapeutic exercise.
  - Supervise staff and volunteers who will be participating and helping in the speech therapy programs.
  - Give training to other staff as required.
- Internal Liaison
  - Communicate with multidisciplinary team and child care workers regarding treatment schedule and update.
  - Attend Case Review meetings and provide case summary, assessment and progress charts as relevant.
  - Attend staff meetings as arranged.
- Personal Development
  - Participate in staff training programs and other relevant professional meetings as required.
  - Undertake professional development activities to ensure update of knowledge.
- Other duties as required.

### Requirements

- Degree in Speech and Hearing Sciences or above, or equivalent;
- With a minimum of two years of experience in working with young children with special needs preferred;
- Excellent command of both spoken and written English and Chinese;
- Have excellent communication and interpersonal skill;
- Able to work in a multi-cultural environment;
- Must share the commitment of Mother's Choice in upholding the safety and protection of children as paramount.
