Position Description

The Health Worker perform direct care to maintain wellbeing of children, assist with medication management and administration under nurse guidance and provide care to the children under Mothers Choice 'Children's Services'.

Key Responsibilities

- Perform daily routines for babies/children with special needs including feeding, bathing, diapers changing, toilet training, etc.
- Perform simple exercises for the babies/children as instructed by therapists
- Administer simple clinical procedure (e.g. gastrostomy feeding & care, colostomy care, bipap care, etc.)
- Assist nurses in performing health checks and other staff with children's hospital, medical appointments and follow ups.
- Accompany babies/children for medical appointments
- Ensure safe medication administration and storage procedures, and adhere to controlled substance regulations.
- Keep clear documentation of medical inventory to date.
- Keep proper record for accurate handover to existing current nurses.
- Ensure hygienic environment and protect children, families, staff and volunteers by advising, monitoring and adhering to Department of Health guidelines on infection-control policies and protocols.
- Promote children's health and development by collaborating with our EIS team.
- Maintain professional and technical knowledge by attending educational workshops, reviewing professional publications, or as required by Mother's Choice.
- Perform other ad-hoc related duties, as required.

Requirements

- Valid Health Worker registration certificate under the Residential Care Homes for Persons with Disabilities
- Compassionate and committed to excellence.
- Keen to learn, good team worker but also able to work independently.
- Cantonese speaking with knowledge in basic spoken English
- Basic computer skills
- Shift duty required, possibility to stay overnight in case of emergency (e.g. typhoons and rainstorms)
- Must share the commitment of Mother's Choice in upholding the safety and protection of children as paramount.
